Pope Francis Appoints New Bishop for Diocese of Salina

Pope Francis named Monsignor Gerald Lee Vincke, Bishop Elect of the Diocese of Salina. His current assignment with the Diocese of Lansing is Pastor of Holy Family Parish in Grand Blanc, Michigan. Msgr. Vincke currently serves on the Presbyteral Council, the Priest Assignment Committee and the College of Consultors of the Diocese of Lansing. Bishop-elect Vincke is scheduled to be ordained and installed as the 12th Bishop of Salina at Sacred Heart Cathedral on Wednesday, August 22nd. This is an invitation-only event because of the amount of people who attend and the limited seating in the Cathedral. Please pray for Bishop-Elect Vincke as our Diocese prepares to ordain him Bishop. There will be a meet and greet in Victoria on Sunday, August 26th at 3:00 pm. There will be a prayer service (not a Mass) in the church followed by a reception in the school gymnasium. Everyone is welcome to attend.
