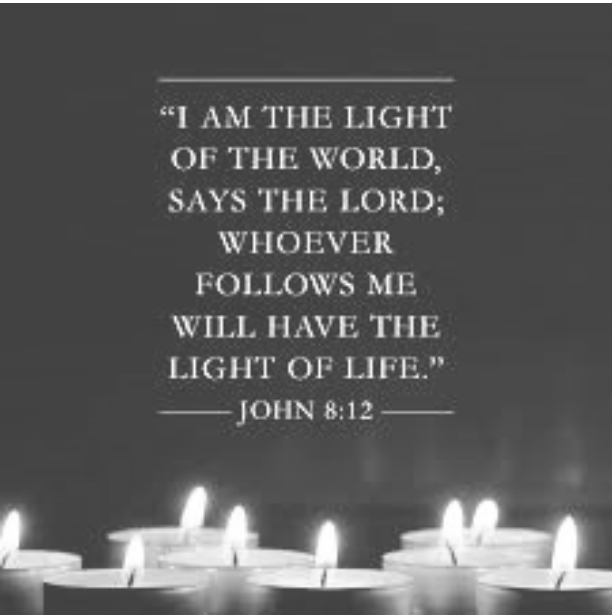
We are working closely with the Diocese and will continue to have priests for Tuesday and weekend Masses. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the parish office.
