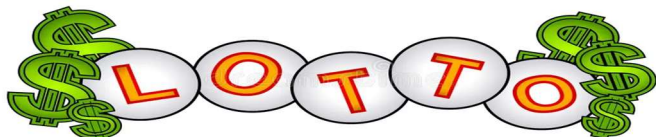
2025-2026 School Lotto
